## What's Happened So Far?

March 2017: Presentations at QAC on mortality data from NYC and NYS and on mortality review from Dr. Steve Johnson (University of Colorado Denver) and Dr. Sandy Schwarcz (UCSF)

April 2017: Formation of Mortality Subcommittee

**April - August 2017**: Meeting of mortality subcommittee (and subgroups of subcommittee) focused on adapting the CoDe tool

## What's Happened So Far?

**September 2017:** Presentation of adapted CoDe tool at QAC. Feedback given by members.

**September 2017- March 2018**: Revision of CoDe tool based on feedback and further discussions with subcommittee cochairs.

March 2018: Presentation of revisions to adapted CoDe tool at QAC meeting



## What's Next?

- At AI: Review of administrative data sets to identify number of AIDS-related deaths in 2017
- Mortality review using the adapted CoDe on hold
  - Tool can be used by individual programs for their own internal quality reviews
  - Al led review will be revisited when there is new staff
